

Postcard Two (make 2)

Follow instructions for Postcard One in Week 1, this time adding some surface crochet seagulls.



Surface Crochet Seagulls

Using the photo as a guide and using Yarn E, crochet simple surface crochet chains for each wing of the seagulls. There are 4 seagulls in total.





Vintage Heart Square (make 4)

Vintage postcards can be so much fun with nostalgic scenes and old photos from a different time. This square encompasses that vintage feeling with a heart to remind us we're sending our postcards with love!

This square is made with the right side (RS) facing at all times.

Using Yarn F, make 4ch, ss to first ch to join into a ring (or make a magic circle).

Round 1 (RS) 3ch (counts as first tr), 11tr into the ring, ss to top of first 3 ch to join. [12 sts]

Round 2 2ch (does not count as st), 1tr in same st at base of 2 ch, 1tr in each of next 2 sts, 8tr in next st, miss next st, 1ss in next st, miss next st, 8tr in next st, 1tr in each of next 3 sts, 7tr in next st, ss to first tr. [30 sts]

Round 3 1ch (does not count as st), 1 htr in same st at base of 1 ch, 1 htr in each of next 6 sts, 3 htr in next st, 3 tr in next st, 1 htr in next st, 1 dc in next st, miss next ss instead working 1 ss into the same st it is worked into below in Round 1, 1 dc in next st, 1 htr in next st, 3 tr in next st, 3 htr in next st, 1 htr in each of next 10 sts, (2 htr, 1 ch, 2 htr) all in next st, 1 htr in each of next 3 sts, ss to first htr, fasten off. [41 sts]

Half Treble stitches are unique in that they have 3 loops/strands at the top of the stitch. Make sure that in Round 4 you are inserting your hook into just the one very back loop only which sits towards the back of the work. This ensures that two strands remain to the front of the work. When working into

the tr and dc stitches at the top of the heart insert hook into a strand behind the stitch to ensure two strands stay to front. This gives the heart a nice crisp border.

Round 4 Join Yarn E into blo of top central ss, 1ch (counts as first st), 1dc in blo of next st and each st around (at the bottom of the heart miss the 1 ch), ss to first ch. [4] sts]

Round 5 1ss in next st, 1dc in next st, * 2ch, miss next st, 1dc in next st, 3ch, miss 2 sts, 1dc in next st, repeat from * six times more, 2ch, miss next st, 1dc in next st, 3ch, miss remaining sts, ss to first dc made (before first 2-ch-sp). [16 ch-sps]

A square will now be created around the heart.

Round 6 1ss in next ch-sp, 2ch (counts as first htr), 2htr in same ch-sp, * miss next st, 3dc in next ch-sp, miss next st, 3htr in next ch-sp, miss next st, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in next ch-sp **, miss next st, 3htr in next ch-sp, repeat from * three times ending final repeat at **, ss to top of first 2 ch, fasten off. [13 sts on each side with 4 x corner 2-ch-sps]

Round 7 Join Yarn G into any corner ch-sp, 3ch (counts as first tr), (1tr, 2ch, 2tr) in same corner ch-sp, *1tr in each st to end of side, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in corner ch-

sp, repeat from * two times, 1tr in each st to end, ss to top of first 3 ch, fasten off. [17 sts on each side with 4 x corner 2-ch-sps]

Round 8 Join Yarn H into any corner ch-sp, 3ch (counts as first tr), (2tr, 2ch, 3tr) in same corner ch-sp, *(miss 2 sts, 3tr in next st) until final 2 sts of side, miss final 2 sts **, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in corner ch-sp, repeat from * three times ending final repeat at **, ss to top of first 3 ch, fasten off. [21 sts on each side with 4 x corner 2-ch-sps]

Round 9 Join Yarn I into any corner ch-sp, 3ch (counts as first tr), (2tr, 2ch, 3tr) in same corner ch-sp, *(miss 3 sts, 3tr into space before next 3-tr group) six times, miss 3 sts **, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in corner ch-sp, repeat from * three times ending final repeat at **, ss to top of first 3 ch, fasten off. [24 sts on each side with 4 x corner 2-ch-sps]

Round 10 Join Yarn E into any corner ch-sp, 3ch (counts as first tr), (2tr, 2ch 3tr) in same corner ch-sp, *(miss 3 sts, 3tr into space before next 3-tr group) seven times, miss 3 sts **, (3tr, 2ch 3tr) in corner ch-sp, repeat from * three times ending final repeat at **, ss to top of first 3 ch, fasten off. [27 sts on each side with 4 x corner 2-ch-sps]



Joining the Squares

The squares and rectangles are joined together with simple double crochet stitches going through the corresponding stitches of both pieces to be joined. The squares and rectangles are joined with the right side (RS) held together so that the double crochet stitches appear to the back of the work and the right side of the work has flat neat joins. Lay out the squares and rectangles using photo as a guide.

Shorter joins

Start by joining the shorter joins between the Vintage Heart squares and Postcards. Join Yarn E through both sts to be joined and make 1ch (does not count as st), work 1dc in each of the 27 sts across the side edge going through both layers, fasten off.

Central join

The central Week One square is then joined to the outer squares and rectangles in one go. Make sure the RS are facing each other and with WS of central square facing you, join Yarn E to any outer right st going through to corresponding st on rectangle to be joined, 1ch (does not count as st), *work 1dc in each of the next 51 sts across going through both layers, when you reach the corner insert hook into corner ch-sp of central square and the corner ch-sp of the Vintage Heart square and work 1dc, repeat from * for each side, after final corner ch-sp ss to first dc and fasten off.
