ROSARIUM STOCKING STITCH HAT PATTERN



Excerpt from pattern number 5755 available from all good yarn retailers

TENSION

6 sts and 9 rows to 10 cm, 4 in, over stocking stitch on 15 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

Using 15 mm needles and thumb method cast on 32 sts firmly.

1 st row (rs): Knit. 2nd row: Purl.

Last 2 rows form st-st (stocking stitch). Cont in st-st until hat measures 15 cm, 6 in, ending with a rs row.

Next row: P1, p2tog, purl to end. 31 sts.

Shape Crown

1 st row: K1, (k2tog, k3) 6 times. 25 sts.
2nd and every foll alt row. Purl.
3rd row: K1, (k2tog, k2) 6 times. 19 sts.
5th row: K1, (k2tog, k1) 6 times. 13 sts.
6th row: (P2tog) 6 times, p1. 7 sts.
Break off yarn, run yarn through rem 7 sts, draw up and fasten off.

TO MAKE UP

Join back seam. Cover with a clean damp tea towel and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

ABBREVIATIONS

alt alternate, cm centimetre(s), cont continue, foll following, in inch(es), k knit, mm millimetre(s), p purl, rs right side, st(s) stitch(es), tog together

To fit an average sized woman's head

MATERIALS REQUIRED

King Cole Rosarium shade Silver Rose (4709) 100g balls x 2

NEEDLES

1 pair 15 mm (USA 19) knitting needles
