

An effective twist creates this beautiful yet simple moss stitch headband

## Willow

Knitted in Mulberry Soft DK
MEASUREMENTS
approximately $11 \times 47 \mathrm{~cm}$ or $4.24 \times 18.5$ in

## MATERIALS REQUIRED

3.75 mm knitting needles

Stitch markers
Stitch holder

## YARN REQUIREMENTS

Mulberry Soft DK $1 \times 50 \mathrm{~g}$ skein

ABBREVIATIONS
cm centimetres sts stitches
cont continue S1 slip one stitch
K knit $\quad$ RS right side
P purl
patt pattern
rep repeat
WS wrong side

## TENSION

27 sts and 40 rows over moss stitch.

It is important to work to the tension stated. Only King Cole yarns are suitable for this pattern. No responsibility will be taken for other yarns used.

Using 3.75 mm needles, cast on 30sts.
1 st Row: (RS) S 1, *K1, P1, rep from * to last sts, K 1 .
2nd Row: S 1, P1, *K1, P1, rep from * to last 2sts, K2.
Last 2 rows set patt.
Keeping continuity of patt cont until Headband measures 22 cm , ending with 1 st row of patt.

## Divide for Twist

Left side of Twist
Next Row: S 1, (P1, K 1 ) 7 times,
turn. Leave rem 15sts on needle for Right side of Twist.
Working on first 15 sts for

Left side of Twist proceed as follows:
Next Row: (RS) S 1, (P 1, K 1)
7 times.
Rep last row 13 times more.
Leave these 15 sts on a stitch holder for Left side of Twist. With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem 15sts for Right side of Twist and proceed as follows:
Next Row: (WS) S1, (K1, P1) 6 times, K2.
Rep last row 13 times more.

## Create Twist

Next Row: (WS) Right side of Twist. S1, (K1, P1) 6 times, K2, with WS of Left side of Twist
facing, work across 15sts left on a stitch holder as follows: S 1, (Pl, K I) 7 times. 30sts. Place a marker at each end of last row.

Next Row: S1, (P1, K1) 14 times, K1.
Next Row: S 1, K 1, (P 1, K1), rep from * to end. Last 2 rows set patt. Cont in patt until Headband measures 22 cm from markers, ending with 2 nd row of patt. Cast off in patt.

## To make up

Join Back Seam. Sew in ends.
