Ice Cream Cushion

This cushion is a follow-up pattern from our Beach Hut KAL blanket. It's a great project for using any yarn left over.

The cone is a simple knit and purl stitch pattern, but you will need to pay attention. There is both a full Chart for the Cone and written instructions for those who do not like to work from Charts.

The listing for foam is optional. The Ice-Cream cone cushion is designed to be almost 2D, it should not be stuffed to form a cylindrical cushion. The foam is used to add some stability, if you do not wish to use the foam, simply use more stuffing (you will need to buy 500g).

Needles:

Straight needles 3.25mm
(UK 10, USA 3)

Also needed:

Stuffing approx. 250g (500g if you are not using foam)
Foam 100cm x 56cm (2.5cm deep) available from Dunelm Mill (optional)

Tension for DK yarns:

24 sts and 34 rows to
10cm (4in) over st st
using 3.25mm needles

Size:

Approx. 70 cm (27.5in)
long x 45 cm (17.75in) wide

beg begin(ning)

K knit

m1 make 1, pick up bar laying between last st just worked and next st, and K into back of loop (inc).

m1l make one left: pick up the bar between the stitch you just knit and the one you're about to knit inserting the left needle from front to back, then knit into the back of the stitch

m1r make one right: pick up the bar between the stitch you just knit and the one you're about to knit inserting the left needle from back to front, then knit into the front of this stitch.

mm millimetres

P purl

rem remain(ing)

rep repeat

RS right side

sl slip

ssk slip 1, slip 1, knit these 2 slipped stitches together through back loops

st(s) stitch(es)

st st stocking stitch

tog together

WS wrong side

MAKE TWO PIECES

With 3.25mm needles and White yarn, cast on 75 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 5: Knit.

Row 7: Knit.

Row 9: K2, m1r, k71, m1l, k2. 77 sts

Row 11: K2, m1r, k73, m1l, k2. 79 sts

Row 13: K2, m1r, k75, m1l, k2. 81 sts

Row 15: K2, m1r, k77, m1l, k2. 83 sts

Row 17: K2, m1r, k79, m1l, k2. 85 sts

Row 19: K2, m1r, k81, m1l, k2. 87 sts

Row 21: Knit.

Row 23: K2, m1r, k83, m1l, k2. 89 sts

Row 25: Knit.

Row 27: K2, m1r, k85, m1l, k2. 91 sts

Row 29: Knit.

Row 31: K2, m1r, k87, m1l, k2. 93 sts

Row 33: Knit.

Row 35: Knit.

Row 37: K2, m1r, k89, m1l, k2. 95 sts

Row 39: Knit.

Row 41: Knit.

Row 43: K2, m1r, k91, m1l, k2. 97 sts

Rows 45-56: Beg with a knit row, work straight in st st as set.

You will now begin Decreasing

Row 57: K1, ssk, k91, k2tog, k1. 95 sts

Row 59: Knit.

Row 61: Knit.

Row 63: K1, ssk, k89, k2tog, k1. 93 sts

Row 65: Knit.

Row 67: Knit.

Row 69: K1, ssk, k87, k2tog, k1. 91 sts

Row 71: Knit.

Row 73: K1, ssk, k85, k2tog, k1. 89 sts

Row 75: Knit.

Row 77: K1, ssk, k83, k2tog, k1. 87 sts

Row 79: Knit.

Row 81: K1, ssk, k81, k2tog, k1. 85 sts

Row 83: Knit.

Row 85: K1, ssk, k79, k2tog, k1. 83 sts

Row 87: K1, ssk, k77, k2tog, k1. 81 sts

Row 89: K1, ssk, k75, k2tog, k1. 79 sts

Row 91: K1, ssk, k73, k2tog, k1. 77 sts

Row 93: K1, ssk, k71, k2tog, k1. 75 sts

Row 95: K1, ssk, k69, k2tog, k1. 73 sts

Row 97: K3, k2tog, k6, (k2tog, k5) six

times, (k2tog, k6) twice, k2tog, k2. 63 sts

Row 98: Purl.

Row 99: K3, (k2tog, k4) three times, (k2tog, k5) twice, (k2tog, k4) four times, k2tog, k2. 53 sts

Cast off.



Cone

MAKE TWO PIECES

With 3.25mm needles and Yellow yarn, cast on 75 sts.

Edge

Rows 1-6: Knit.

Commence working from chart OR follow the written instructions below

Row 1 (RS): K2, (p1, k9, p1, k1) six times, k1. (75 sts)

Row 2 (WS): *(P1, k1) twice, p7, k1; rep from * five times more, p1, k1, p1.

Row 3: K2, (p1, k1, p1, k5, (p1, k1) twice) six times, k1.

Row 4: (P3, k1, p1, k1) 12 times, p3.

Row 5: K4, *(p1, k1) three times, p1, k5; rep from * four times more, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k4.

Row 6: P5, *(k1, p1) twice, k1, p7; rep from * four times more, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p5.

Row 7: K6, (p1, k1, p1, k9) five times, p1, k1, p1, k6.

Row 8: Repeat row 6.

Row 9: Repeat row 5.

Row 10: Repeat row 4.

Row 11: Repeat row 3.

Row 12: Repeat row 2.

Row 13: Repeat row 1.

Row 14: Repeat row 2.

Row 15: Repeat row 3.

Row 16: Repeat row 4.

Row 17: K1, ssk, k1, *(p1, k1) three times, p1, k5; rep from * four times more, (p1, k1)

four times, k2tog, k1. 73 sts

Row 18: P4, *(k1, p1) twice, k1, p7; rep from * four times more, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p4.

Row 19: K5, (p1, k1, p1, k9) five times, p1, k1, p1, k5.

Row 20: Repeat row 18.

Row 21: K1, ssk, *(p1, k1) three times, p1, k5; rep from * four times more, (p1, k1)

three times, p1, k2tog, k1. 71 sts

Row 22: P1, (k1, p1, k1, p3) 11 times, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 23: K2, (p1, k5, (p1, k1) three times) five times, p1, k5, p1, k2.

Row 24: P9, *(k1, p1) twice, k1, p7; rep from * four times more, k1, p1.

Row 25: K1, ssk, k7, (p1, k1, p1, k9) four times, p1, k1, p1, k7, k2tog, k1. 69 sts

Row 26: P8, *(k1, p1) twice, k1, p7; rep from * three times more, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p8.

Row 27: (K1, p1, k5, (p1, k1) twice, p1) five times, k1, p1, k5, p1, k1.

Row 28: P2, (k1, p3, k1, p1) 10 times, k1, p3, k1, p2.

Row 29: K1, ssk, *(p1, k1) twice, p1, k5, p1, k1; rep from * four times more, p1, k1, p1,

k2tog, k1. 67 sts

Row 30: P3, (k1, p1, k1, p7, k1, p1) five times, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 31: K2, (p1, k1, p1, k9) five times, p1, k1, p1, k2.

Row 32: Repeat row 30.

Row 33: K1, ssk, *(k1, p1) twice, k5, p1, k1, p1; rep from * four times more, k1, k2tog, k1. 65 sts

Row 34: P4, (k1, p1, k1, p3) nine times, k1, p1, k1, p4.

Row 35: (K5, (p1, k1) 3 times, p1) five times, k5.

Row 36: P6, *(k1, p1) twice, k1, p7; rep from * three times more, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p6.

Row 37: K1, ssk, k4, (p1, k1, p1, k9) four times, p1, k1, p1, k4, k2tog, k1. 63 sts

Row 38: P5, *(k1, p1) twice, k1, p7; rep from * three times more, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p5.

Row 39: K4, *(p1, k1) three times, p1, k5; rep from * three times more, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k4.

Row 40: (P3, k1, p1, k1) 10 times, p3.

Row 41: K1, ssk, (k1, p1, k5, (p1, k1) twice, p1) four times, k1, p1, k5, p1, k1, k2tog, k1. 61 sts

Row 42: P2, (k1, p7, (k1, p1) twice) four times, k1, p7, k1, p2.

Row 43: (K1, p1, k9, p1) five times, k1.

Row 44: Repeat row 42.

Row 45: K1, ssk, (p1, k5, (p1, k1) three times) four times, p1, k5, p1, k2tog, k1. 59 sts

Row 46: P3, (k1, p3, k1, p1) nine times, k1, p1.

Row 47: K2, *(p1, k1) three times, p1, k5; rep from * three times more, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k2.

Row 48: P3, *(k1, p1) twice, k1, p7; rep from * three times more, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p3.

Row 49: K1, ssk, k1, (p1, k1, p1, k9) four times, (p1, k1) twice, k2tog, k1. 57 sts

Row 50: P2, *(k1, p1) twice, k1, p7; rep from * three times more, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p2.

Row 51: K1, *(p1, k1) three times, p1, k5; rep from * three times more, (p1, k1) four times.

Row 52: P2, (k1, p3, k1, p1) eight times, k1, p3, k1, p2.

Row 53: K1, ssk, k4, *(p1, k1) three times, p1, k5; rep from * twice more, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k4, k2tog, k1. 55 sts

Row 54: (P7, (k1, p1) twice, k1) four times, p7.

Row 55: K8, (p1, k1, p1, k9) three times, p1, k1, p1, k8.

Row 56: Repeat row 54.

Row 57: K1, ssk, k3, *(p1, k1) three times, p1, k5; rep from * twice more, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k3, k2tog, k1. 53 sts

Row 58: P4, (k1, p1, k1, p3) seven times, k1, p1, k1, p4.

Row 59: *(K1, p1) three times, k5, p1; rep from * three times more, (k1, p1) twice, k1.

Row 60: P2, (k1, p1, k1, p7, k1, p1) four times, k1, p2.

Row 61: K1, ssk, (p1, k9, p1, k1) three times, p1, k9, p1, k2tog, k1. 51 sts

Row 62: P3, (k1, p7, (k1, p1) twice) four times.

Row 63: K2, p1, k1, p1, (k5, (p1, k1) three times, p1) three times, k5, (p1, k1) twice, k1.

Row 64: (P3, k1, p1, k1) eight times, p3.

Row 65: K1, ssk, k1, *(p1, k1) three times, p1, k5; rep from * twice more, (p1, k1) four times, k2tog, k1. 49 sts

Row 66: P4, *(k1, p1) twice, k1, p7; rep from * twice more, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p4.

Row 67: K5, (p1, k1, p1, k9) three times, p1, k1, p1, k5.

Row 68: Repeat row 66.

Row 69: K1, ssk, *(p1, k1) three times, p1, k5; rep from * twice more, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k2tog, k1. 47 sts

Row 70: P3, (k1, p3, k1, p1) seven times, k1, p1.

Row 71: K2, (p1, k5, (p1, k1) three times) three times, p1, k5, p1, k2.

Row 72: (P1, k1, p7, k1, p1, k1) three times, p1, k1, p7, k1, p1.

Row 73: K1, ssk, k7, (p1, k1,

p1, k9) twice, p1, k1, p1, k7, k2tog, k1. 45 sts

Row 74: P8, *(k1, p1) twice, k1, p7; rep from * once more, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p8.

Row 75: (K1, p1, k5, (p1, k1) twice, p1) three times, k1, p1, k5, p1, k1.

Row 76: P2, (k1, p3, k1, p1) six times, k1, p3, k1, p2.

Row 77: K1, ssk, *(p1, k1) twice, p1, k5, p1, k1; rep from * twice more, p1, k1, p1, k2tog, k1. 43 sts

Row 78: P3, (k1, p1, k1, p7, k1, p1) three times, k1, p3.

Row 79: K2, (p1, k1, p1, k9) three times, p1, k1, p1, k2.

Row 80: Repeat row 78.

Row 81: K1, ssk, *(k1, p1) twice, k5, p1, k1, p1; rep from * twice more, k1, k2tog, k1. 41 sts

Row 82: P4, (k1, p1, k1, p3) five times, k1, p1, k1, p4.

Row 83: (K5, (p1, k1) three times, p1) three times, k5.

Row 84: P6, *(k1, p1) twice, k1, p7; rep from * once more, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p6.

Row 85: K1, ssk, k4, (p1, k1, p1, k9) twice, p1, k1, p1, k4, k2tog, k1. 39 sts

Row 86: P5, *(k1, p1) twice, k1, p7; rep from * once more, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p5.

Row 87: K4, *(p1, k1) three times, p1, k5; rep from * once more, (p1, k1) three

times, p1, k4.

Row 88: (P3, k1, p1, k1) six times, p3.

Row 89: K1, ssk, (k1, p1, k5, (p1, k1) twice, p1) twice, k1, p1, k5, p1, k1, k2tog, k1. 37 sts

Row 90: P2, (k1, p7, (k1, p1) twice) twice, k1, p7, k1, p2.

Row 91: (K1, p1, k9, p1) three times, k1.

Row 92: Repeat row 90.

Row 93: K1, ssk, (p1, k5, (p1, k1) three times) twice, p1, k5, p1, k2tog, k1. 35 sts

Row 94: P1, (k1, p1, k1, p3) five times, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 95: K2, *(p1, k1) three times, p1, k5; rep from * once more, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k2.

Row 96: P3, *(k1, p1) twice, k1, p7; rep from * once more, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p3.

Row 97: K1, ssk, k1, (p1, k1, p1, k9) twice, (p1, k1) twice, k2tog, k1. 33 sts

Row 98: P2, *(k1, p1) twice, k1, p7; rep from * once more, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p2.

Row 99: K1, *(p1, k1) three times, p1, k5; rep from * once more, (p1, k1) four times.

Row 100: P2, (k1, p3, k1, p1) five times, p1.

Row 101: K1, ssk, k4, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k5, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k4, k2tog, k1. 31 sts

Row 102: (P7, (k1, p1) twice, k1) twice, p7.

Row 103: K8, p1, k1, p1, k9, p1, k1, p1, k8.

Row 104: Repeat row 102.

Row 105: K1, ssk, k3, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k5, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k3, k2tog, k1. 29 sts

Row 106: P4, (k1, p1, k1, p3) four times, p1.

Row 107: K3, (p1, k1, p1, k5, (p1, k1) twice) twice, p1, k1.

Row 108: P2, (k1, p1, k1, p7, k1, p1) twice, k1, p2.

Row 109: K1, ssk, p1, k9, p1, k1, p1, k9, p1, k2tog, k1. 27 sts

Row 110: *(P1, k1) twice, p7, k1; rep from * once more, p1, k1, p1.

Row 111: K2, p1, k1, p1, k5, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k5, (p1, k1) twice, k1.

Row 112: (P3, k1, p1, k1) four times, p3.

Row 113: K1, ssk, (k1, p1) four times, k5, (p1, k1) four times, k2tog, k1. 25 sts

Row 114: P4, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p7, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p4.

Row 115: K5, p1, k1, p1, k9, p1, k1, p1, k5.

Row 116: Repeat row 114.

Row 117: K1, ssk, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k5, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k2tog, k1. 23 sts

Row 118: P1, (k1, p1, k1, p3)

three times, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 119: K2, p1, k5, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k5, p1, k2.

Row 120: P1, k1, p7, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p7, k1, p1.

Row 121: K1, ssk, k7, p1, k1, p1, k7, k2tog, k1. 21 sts

Row 122: P8, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p8.

Row 123: K1, p1, k5, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k5, p1, k1.

Row 124: P2, (k1, p3, k1, p1) twice, k1, p3, k1, p2.

Row 125: K1, ssk, (p1, k1) twice, p1, k5, (p1, k1) twice, p1, k2tog, k1. 19 sts

Row 126: (P1, k1) three times, p7, (k1, p1) three times.

Row 127: K2, p1, k1, p1, k9, p1, k1, p1, k2.

Row 128: Repeat row 126

Row 129: K1, ssk, (k1, p1) twice, k5, (p1, k1) twice, k2tog, k1. 17 sts

Row 130: P4, k1, p1, k1, p3, k1, p1, k1, p4.

Row 131: K5, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k5.

Row 132: P6, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p6.

Row 133: K1, ssk, k4, p1, k1, p1, k4, k2tog, k1. 15 sts

Row 134: P5, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p5.

Row 135: K4, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k4.

Row 136: (P3, k1, p1, k1) twice, p3.

Row 137: K1, ssk, k1, p1, k5, p1, k1, k2tog, k1. 13 sts

Row 138: P2, k1, p7, k1, p2.

Row 139: K1, p1, k9, p1, k1.

Row 140: Repeat row 138.

Row 141: K1, ssk, p1, k5, p1, k2tog, k1. 11 sts

Row 142: (P3, k1) twice, p3.

Row 143: K2, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k2.

Row 144: P3, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p3.

Row 145: K4, p1, k1, p1, k4.

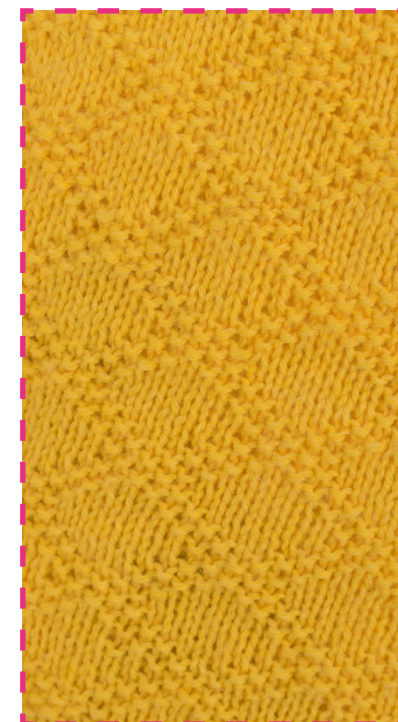
Row 146: P5, k1, p5.

Row 147: Knit.

Row 148: Purl.

Rows 149 - 150: Repeat rows 147 - 148.

Cast off.



Making Up

Block all pieces.

Using Fuchsia, Turquoise and Saxe use image as a guide to embroider on Sprinkles to both sides of the Scoop. Overlapping the Cone slightly with the Scoop pin the cast on edge of cone to cast on edge of Scoop. Once happy sew together securely.

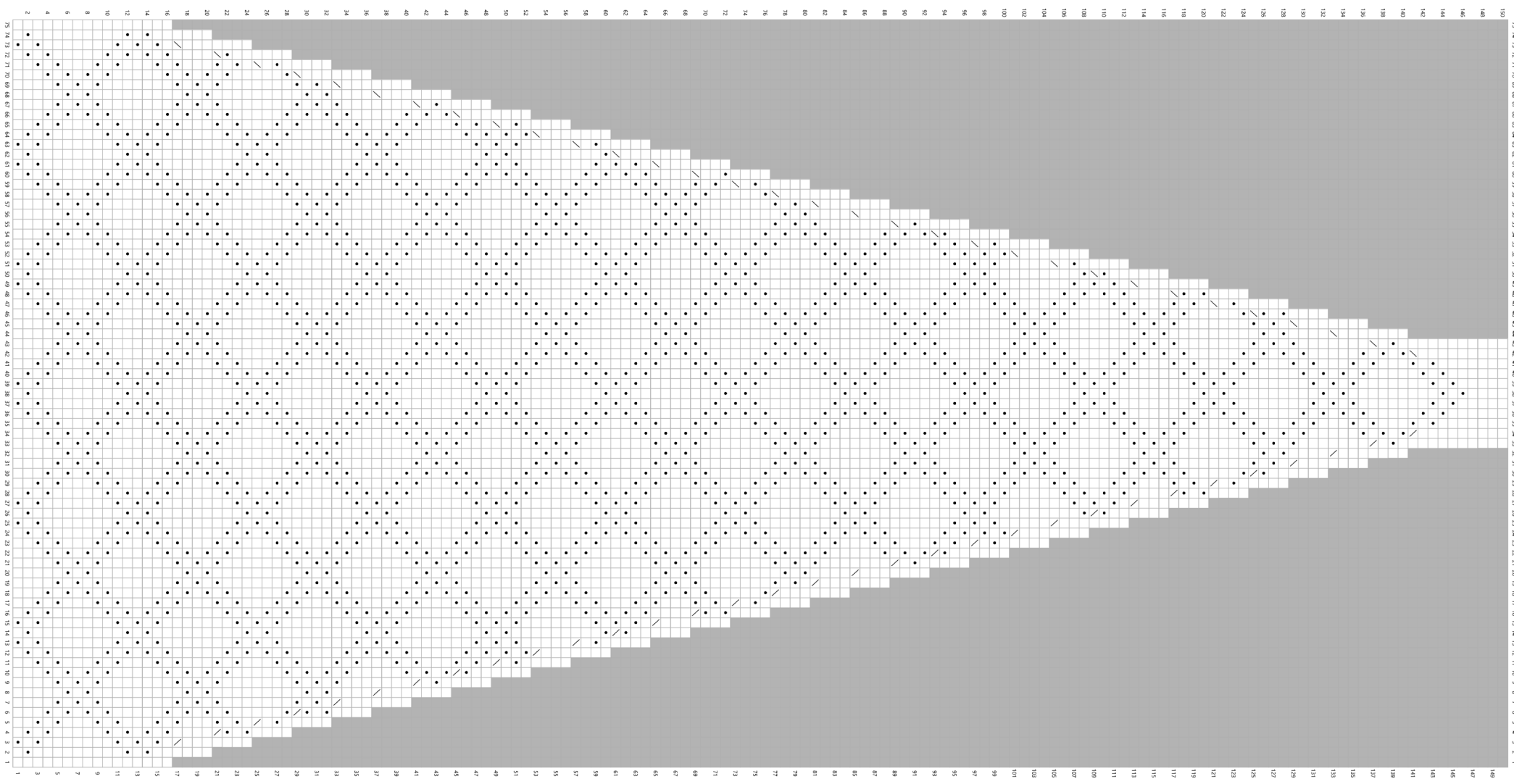
If using foam, lay one of the Scoop and Cone piece (now sewn together) on to the foam and use this as a template to draw around. Using sharp scissors or a craft knife cut around the outline approx. 1cm inside the line, (you will want the foam to be a little smaller than the knitted piece).

Using mattress stitch sew

one of the sides together from tip of Cone to top of Scoop. Slip the foam inside the knitted piece. If you are NOT using foam then continue to sew around the edge of the knitted pieces stuffing as you go.

If you ARE using foam, gently stuff around the edge of the foam, this will stop the colour of the foam showing through the knitted piece and soften the edges. Sew the other side of the knitted piece adding stuffing as you work. You will need to gently pad the edge all the way round and add enough stuffing to produce a slightly rounded shape (use the image as a guide). Sew in ends and snuggle up!
