Summer Top Knitted in Naturally Soft 4Ply



TENSION

28sts and 36 rows to 10cm, 4in over st-st using 3.25mm needles. It is important to work to the tension stated. Only King Cole yarns are suitable for this pattern. No responsibility will be taken for other yarns used.

ABBREVIATIONS

alt alternate
beg beginning
cont continue

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

1x1 Rib:

1st Row: *K1, P1, rep from * to last st, K1.
2nd Row: P1, *K1, P1, rep from * to end.
Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

M1 Make one stitch: Pick loop between last and next stitch and work into the back of this loop.

St-st Stocking Stitch: 1st row: Knit 2nd Row: Purl.
Rep 1st and 2nd rows

FRONT

Using 2.75mm needles cast on 97 [111:125:139:153]sts and work in 1x1 rib for 10cm, ending with a ws row.

Change to 3.25mm needles and working in st-st (throughout) work 6 rows.

Shape Sides.

1st Row: K2, m1, knit to last 2sts, m1, K2. 99 [113:127:141:155]sts.

2nd Row: Purl.

1st and 2nd rows set side shaping. Work 55 rows inc 1 st at each end as before in 13th and every foll 14th row. 107 [121:135:149:163]sts. Cont without shaping until Front measures 32cm, ending with a ws row.

Shape Armholes.

Cast off 8sts at beg of 2 rows.

91 [105:119:133:147]sts.

Work 4 [4:6:10:14] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row.

83 [97:107:113:119]sts.

Work 7 [9:11:11:11] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row.

75 [87:95:101:107]sts. **

Cont without shaping until armholes measure 7 [9:11:13:14]cm, ending with a ws row.

Shape Neck.

Next Row: K26 [32:34:37:38]sts, turn, leave rem 49 [55:61:64:69]sts on a stitch holder.

Working on these 26 [32:34:37:38] sts only proceed as follows:-

Next Row: Purl.

Work 4 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row. 22 [28:30:33:34]sts.

Work 7 rows dec 1 st at neck edge

in next and every foll alt row.

18 [24:26:29:30]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 17 [19:21:23:24]cm, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

With rs facing, working on rem 49 [55:61:64:69]sts, slip 23 [23:27:27:31]sts onto a stitch holder, rejoin yarn to rem 26 [32:34:37:38]sts and knit to end.

Next Row: Purl.

Work 4 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row. 22 [28:30:33:34]sts.

Work 7 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll alt row. 18 [24:26:29:30]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 17 [19:21:23:24]cm, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

BACK

Work exactly as given for Front until ** is reached.

Cont without shaping until armholes measure 17 [19:21:23:24]cm, ending with a ws row.

Next Row: Cast off

18 [24:26:29:30]sts,

K38 [38:42:42:46], cast off rem

18 [24:26:29:30]sts.

Leave rem 39 [39:43:43:47]sts on a stitch holder.

NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam. With rs facing, using 2.75mm needles pick up and knit 35sts evenly along left side of neck, knit across

23 [23:27:27:31]sts left on a stitch holder at front of neck, pick up and knit 36sts evenly along right side of neck and knit across

39 [39:43:43:47]sts left on a stitch holder at back of neck.

133 [133:141:141:149]sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Commencing with 1st row of 1x1 rib work 8 rows.

Cast off loosely in rib.

ARMHOLE BORDERS (Both Alike)

Join left shoulder and Neckband seams. With rs facing, using 2.75mm needles pick up and knit 125 [137:149:161:177]sts evenly all round armhole edge.

Next Row: Knit.

Commencing with 1st row of 1x1 rib work 8 rows. Cast off in rib.

TO MAKE UP

Join side and Armhole Border seams. See ball band for pressing and care instructions. Dry flat and re-shape whilst damp.
